



Interview Questions for Mission Partners

The interview time allows you to stay in control and keep the conversation interesting and informative. Instruct mission partners to keep their responses short so you can ask them many questions. As time allows, ask a variety of questions about their personal lives, ministry, and any prayer requests.

1. Briefly tell us how you came to faith in Christ.
2. Tell us about your family.
3. What was the main influence that led to you become a missionary?
4. How did God call you to become a missionary?
5. What advice would you give someone who is considering cross-cultural service?
6. Tell us about the area where you serve. What is the spiritual condition of the people you serve?
7. What is the greatest obstacle to reaching people for Christ?
8. Can you tell us the story of a person whose life was changed as a result of the ministry where you serve?
9. What are some of the strategies you are using to reach the people where you serve?
10. Beyond finances and prayers, which we all know is important, what is one way that our church can come alongside and support your ministry?
